Minutes of the Parish Council Planning Committee held on Wednesday 23rd August 2006 at 7.30 p.m. in the Jubilee Hall, Timsbury.

4. Planning Applications.

4.1 Temporary storage of inert screen materials, crushing of concrete, and sorting of lightweight materials, processing and storage of wood, storage of portaloos and skips, Ace Liftaway, Yokesford Hill.

Councillors' Pritchett-Brown and Subramanyam had attended presentations on the two applications at Ace Lifaway's premises. Both were impressed by the company's attitude and willingness to be helpful when concerns were raised. For example they had altered the lorry reverse warning sound when local residents had found it intrusive. The Parish Council had no objection to this application.

4.2 Temporary overnight storage of skips and vehicles, temporary storage of astroturf and storage of portaloos in building 2, Ace Liftaway Yokesford Hill.

The Parish Council's view was similar to the first application and there was no objection.

4.3 Demolition of existing two-storey extension and outbuildings and erection of two-storey rear and side extension with single storey rear extension, Forsythia, New Road.

The Parish Council considered that this proposal would be an improvement on the existing extension to the property. There was no objection.
