Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on Wednesday 28th September 2011 at 7.30 p.m. at the Jubilee Hall, Timsbury.

Police Update from PCSO Jo Cole

PCSO Cole gave the meeting a comprehensive update of local police matters, including a growing concern regarding diesel thefts from businesses in the location of Bunny Lane and of lead thefts from some of the local schools.

However, PCSO Cole informed the meeting that the surrounding area has a relatively low crime rate.

A suggestion to improve security on the Recreation Ground was put forward by PCSO Cole to help discourage travellers in the future.

PCSO Cole informed the meeting that parishioners should attempt to capture the registration number of any speeding cars through the village and report them to the police, in order to assist with subsequent prosecutions.

Planning Matters

Parishioner, Mr. John Lawson asked the Parish Council if it would be commenting on the Test Valley Development Framework Plan.

Cllr. Tony Ward stated that there is a webpage to update parishioners with all the latest actions regarding the plan.
