PLANNING

Planning Applications Reviewed at the Parish Council Meeting on 28 November

18/02968/TPOS: Tree works – The Old Station, Mottisfont

Decision: No comment

18/02811/TPOS: Tree Works – 4 Redlands Drive, Upper Timsbury.

The applicant explained the background to this application; the trees in question were not on land in his ownership but had been judged to require coppicing or reducing on safety grounds. It was noted that TVBC had granted the application on 27 November and therefore the Parish Council did not debate the application.

18/02974/TPOS: Tree works – Hoggetts, Oak Tree Lane

Decision: No comment

18/02971: Tree works – Tree Tops, Hill View Road

Decision: No comment

18/02861/FULLS: Remodelling and Extension of garage – Nursery House, Stockbridge Road

Decision: The Council expressed concern that the changes to the garage would result in what was effectively a separate dwelling, and would ask TVBC to ensure that if consent is given this should be subject to a condition that the building would only be used as ancillary accommodation to the main house.

18/03063/FULLS: Single storey rear extension - 8 Casbrook Field, Upper Timsbury.

Decision: No objection. The drawing attached to the application showed the location of the proposed extension but also showed a proposed summerhouse. The application did not refer to this and it would be queried with TVBC.

VILLAGE NEWS

The Virgin sales event previously arranged for 18 December has been rescheduled and will now take place in the Jubilee Hall **on Friday 11 January** between 5 and 9 pm. At the event Virgin will update residents on connection costs and the services available via the system.

The Parish Council is aware that some residents are not satisfied with the quality of the restoration work carried out by Virgin's contractors. If you have any queries or concerns about the quality of the repairs carried out after the cable installation, please contact the on-site team or Virgin Media directly by emailing ExpansionWorks@virginmedia.co.uk or call 0333 000 5925 Option 1.

The Parish Council has some concerns about the quality of the road surface repairs although these may be temporary at this stage. Depending on the finished condition the Council will produce a defects list and will contact Virgin, and HCC Highways, to press for remedial works. If you have any comments on specific road surface repairs, or are unable to obtain satisfaction from Virgin about work on your property, please provide the information to the Parish Clerk.
