4. Planning Applications

4.1 20/00106/TPOS

(Tagged numbers) Poplars – reduce by up to 10 metres, T343 Poplar – fell and replace with standard fastigate Oak or other species specified by TVBC

Site: Woodland to the South Wests of 1 Casbrook Field, Upper Timsbury

The Parish Council agreed that the poplars referred to in this application are the subject of TPOs and in the Council's opinion are an important feature in the immediate area – they 'frame' the western boundary of this group of houses - and in the context of the wider landscape.

The Parish Council is concerned that the 'Preliminary Tree Works Management Plan' submitted with this application does not provide any evidence relating to the condition of the specified trees.

The Parish Council objects to the reduction or felling of these trees unless the works are shown to be necessary to maintain the health of the trees or on safety grounds.
